A San Antonio record 22 steals in conjunction with 28 total Tulsa turnovers caused the Shock to fall, 87-75, to the Silver Stars on June 11. The loss was Tulsa's second straight and dropped the Shock to 3-5 on the season and 1-3 on the road. After holding a two-point lead at half, Tulsa's first point in the second half came at the 7:07 mark in the third quarter off a free throw from Scholonda Robinson. The Shock did not score a field goal until 6:24 in the quarter off a bucket from Kara Braxton.

During the first quarter the Shock committed 11 turnovers and the Silver Stars were unable to capitalize on any. In the second half Tulsa committed 17 turnovers off of which the Silver Stars were able to score 18 points.

The Shock were riding a two-game winning streak before traveling to Chicago and suffering its worst loss of the season, 95-70. The 25-point difference was the largest margin of victory in Sky history. Shanna Crossley was red-hot from behind the arc, shooting 5-6 on her way to a 20-point effort. Scholonda Robinson came off the bench to add 15 points, but it wasn't enough to overcome a career effort by Chicago's Sylvia Fowles, who had 32 points and 13 rebounds in the game. Tulsa never led in the game, and Chicago put it away after a 25-4 run in the fourth quarter. Rookie guard Natasha Lacy continued her run of consecutive games with at least five assists, extending that streak to six games with a team-high seven assists. The game was the first of a four-game road trip for the Shock. They have the week off before traveling to San Antonio on Friday to seek revenge on a loss to the Silver Stars earlier in the season.

The Tulsa Shock picked up their second straight win and third in four games as they defeated the Minnesota Lynx 92-79 at the BOK Center Friday night.

Scholanda Robinson led the Shock with a career high 20 points as the Shock improved to 3-3 on the season and 2-1 over the Lynx. Tulsa held Minnesota to just 38.2 percent from the field and won the turnover battle 21-18.

Tulsa shot 50 percent from the field on 32 of 64 shooting, including 9 of 17 from beyond the arc. The Shock led for the majority, falling behind by just three in the first quarter and leading by as much as 22 in the third. Five Shock players scored in double digits.

Rookie guard Natasha Lacy continued her hot streak, scoring in double figures for the second straight game and dish at least five assists in five straight. She also played a career high in minutes, playing nearly 32 in the game.

Chante Black also continued a streak, grabbing at least ten rebounds in four straight games and five of six this season.

- Named for its defensive intensity, not offensive pace

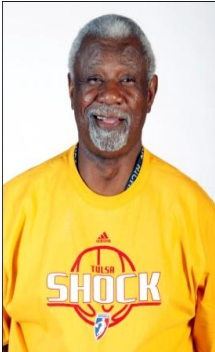

WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
